



awning is on the northeast corner of this facade. The ground level features small, deeply recessed windows. The upper story has one-over-one, double-hung sash windows with stong lugsills and arched lintels. A few windows have metal awnings.

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20. Description of environment and outbuildings.

115 E. Broadway is in a row of commercial buildings which are adjacent to the Hall of Waters. A walkway on the east side leads to the rear of the building, and is separated from the grounds of the Hall of Waters by a low limestone wall. Commercial buildings are also across E. Broadway to the north.

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21. History and significance

115 E. Broadway was constructed in 1908, along with the nearly identical buildings to the west at 111 and 109 E. Broadway. In 1909, it contained the Oriental Bazaar gift shop. In 1913, dental offices were on the ground floor, and office space on the second. Although somewhat altered on the ground level, it still retains its integrity from the historic period.
